WHEREAS the Interim Rule is designed to implement the *National Guard and Reservists Debt Relief Act of 2008*; and


WHEREAS the adoption of the Interim Rule requires immediate approval without providing sufficient time to promulgate rules or the appropriate public notice and opportunity for comments;
