ORDER

Whereas, on October 17, 2005, this Court entered an Order adopting certain Interim Bankruptcy Rules that were adopted by the Judicial Conference of the United States in response to the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2005 (the Act); and


Whereas, this Court further adopted Interim Bankruptcy Rule 1007 on September 28, 2006; and


Whereas, the Supreme Court on April 23, 2008, formally adopted revised Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure to replace the Interim Rules; and


Whereas, the effective date of the aforementioned amendment to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure is December 1, 2008, and would govern all proceedings in bankruptcy cases thereafter commenced, and insofar as just and practicable, all proceedings then pending; and

IT IS SO ORDERED that this Court's orders adopting Interim Bankruptcy Rules as noted here are hereby vacated, and all proceedings in the Bankruptcy Court shall be governed by the Amended Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure effective as of December 1, 2008.
