ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER #121 ON CHANGE TO LOCAL RULES EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 1, 2019

It is hereby ordered that the following rule of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Middle District of Georgia is amended effective November 1, 2019:

LBR 1002-1 Petition - General

LBR 1002-1 currently addresses the requirement for a pro se debtor to provide a photo identification to the Clerk at the time of filing. The rule is amended to also require a pro se debtor to file the local form "Pro Se Debtor Statement of Assistance Received in Connection with the Filing of This Case." The form will be provided by the Clerk's office to pro se debtors and shall be placed in the Clerk's Instructions.

On or after the effective date as noted above, this rule shall govern all proceedings then pending or thereafter brought to the court.

It is further ordered that this rule be entered in the record upon the minutes of the court for each of the statutory divisions and that copies be made available by the Clerk of Court to officers and members of the Bar of this court and furnished to the Eleventh Circuit Court of Appeals.
