Subject: Proposed LBR 1002-1 Pro Se Debtor's Statement of Assistance September 23, 2019

- 1. To help identify Bankruptcy Petition Preparer assistance to pro se debtors in preparing bankruptcy petitions, the court desires that all pro se debtors file with the Court a "Debtor's Statement of Assistance" which will more explicitly show whether the pro se debtor received assistance in connection with the filing of the case.
- 2. The proposed local rule will be added to LBR 1002-1 Petition General. The rule will be restyled to include a subparagraph (a) (the current local rule regarding the requirement for unrepresented parties to file a photo ID with the petition) and the new subparagraph (b):

LBR 1002-1 Petition - General. (amended November 1, 2019)

- (a) Any unrepresented party filing a bankruptcy petition with the Court, to include both of the joint debtors and of petitioning creditors, shall provide a photo identification to the Clerk at the time of filing, either in person at the Clerk's office or by mail, facsimile, or email filing. The photo identification may be a valid or expired government issued identification card. The photo will be appended to the petitioner's Bankruptcy Form B121, "Your Statement About Your Social Security Numbers" and filed as a restricted document by the Clerk's office. Failure to produce a photo identification will not prevent the Clerk's office from accepting the petition.
- (b) Any unrepresented party filing a bankruptcy petition to include both the debtor and the debtor's spouse in a joint case and each of the petitioning creditors in a petition for an involuntary bankruptcy shall file with the Court a Debtor's Statement of Assistance in the form found in the Clerk's Instructions. Such statement shall be filed with the petition.
- 3. The proposed form is attached. Once filed with the court, the form will be docketed in the case and electronically noticed to all interested parties who receive Notice of Electronic Filing.
