

**LBR 2091-1. ATTORNEYS - WITHDRAWALS**

Any attorney or law firm who has made an appearance in any case in this Court on behalf of an interested party shall continue to represent that party in the case until excused by the Court. An ~~No~~ attorney or law firm, having filed a petition or other pleading on behalf of a debtor, shall represent the debtor in any contested matters or adversary proceedings that are filed in the case. Upon request by motion with notice given pursuant to LBR 9007-1 or LBR 2002-1(e), the Court will consider excusing the attorney from further representation for cause shown. ~~or having made an appearance for a creditor in a contested matter or adversary proceeding, shall thereafter abandon the case or adversary proceeding in which the appearance was made, or withdraw as counsel for any party therein, except by order of the Court obtained after giving notice pursuant to LBR 9007-1 or LBR 2002-1(e).~~
