#### **MEMORANDUM OPINION**

This matter comes before the Court on request of Debtor to proceed *in forma* pauperis in an appeal of this Court's order entered October 21, 2005, dismissing this case in response to the motion of Heritagebank of the South. The order was entered following a hearing on October 17, 2005.

Debtor's motion for authority to proceed *in forma pauperis* contains no financial information from which the Court might make a determination of need. Furthermore, a review of the hearing indicates that

Thus it appears that Debtor has not provided any basis for concluding that he cannot afford to pay the costs of the appeal and, further, there appears to be no issue of law made known to this Court from which the District Court might conclude that the order dismissing the case should be reversed. Certainly there remains the possibility that an issue of law might be raised on appeal for the first time in the District Court. It would, however, seem improper for this Court to base its approval of the motion on such speculative assumption.

Accordingly, the Court will enter an order denying the motion to proceed *in forma* pauperis.
