ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER #114 ON CHANGE TO LBR 9004-1 (COMBINED MOTIONS)

It is hereby ordered that the following rule of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Middle District of Georgia is changed effective September 18, 2017:

LBR 9004-1


LBR 9004-1 (a) provides that motions for relief from stay may be combined with relief requested in §1301 of the Code. The new local rule clarifies that if motions are combined, the filing must contain the appropriate notice for the type of motion filed.

On or after the effective date as noted above, this rule shall govern all proceedings then pending or thereafter brought to the court.

It is further ordered that this rule be entered in the record upon the minutes of the court for each of the statutory divisions and that copies be made available by the Clerk of Court to officers and members of the Bar of this court and furnished to the Eleventh Circuit Court of Appeals.
